

The City of Lampasas, PWSID 1410001, will be issuing notifications to a portion of water customers in response to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) mandated water service line inventory. Customers can expect the notification by mail. The notice is to inform specific customers of a possible required water service line replacement. The inventory categorizes materials of City and Customer owned service lines as either Lead, Non-Lead, Galvanized Requiring Replacement, or Unknown. Currently, there does **NOT** appear to be Lead service lines within the public water system. Only customers with service lines categorized as Galvanized Requiring Replacement or Unknown will receive the notification. We understand customers may have questions and we have attempted to give as much helpful information as possible below in the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) portion of this notification. The service line inventory will continue to change as staff investigate the service lines in question. Some customers may receive a survey requesting information on their service line materials; if known. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q. What is a City owned service line?

A. *The City owned portion of the service line begins at the water main and ends at the water meter. The meter is also owned by the City.*

Q. What is a Customer owned service line?

A. *The Customer owned portion of the service line begins at the water meter, not including the meter, and ends at the building.*

Q. What is a lead service line?

A. *The EPA defined a lead service line as either City or Customer owned that consists of lead piping. Currently, lead service lines do **NOT** appear to be in the City of Lampasas Water System.*

Q. What does Galvanized Requiring Replacement mean?

A. *Galvanized Requiring Replacement (GRR) is defined as the City or Customer owned portion of the service line that consists of galvanized material which may need replacement.*

Q. What is a Non-Lead service line?

A. *A Non-Lead service line is one that never consisted of lead piping.*

Q. What is an Unknown service line?

A. Service lines are categorized as Unknown if City of Lampasas staff has not been able to verify what materials the service line consists of. These service lines are listed as Unknown temporarily and materials will be identified in the future.

Q. Who is responsible for replacing the service lines?

A. The City of Lampasas is required to replace all City owned service lines. The City is also responsible to enforce replacement of Customer owned service lines.

Q. Who will pay for the service line replacement?

A. The City is researching funding opportunities for service line replacements. More details may be provided at a later date.
